OPEN MIC NIGHT

Eastside Music School hosts monthly open mic nights for current students. The open mic night is a great, low pressure opportunity to perform in front of friends and fellow students. Whether you’ve just completed a song or you’re working on your next solo, this is a great motivator to practice and take your skills to the next level.

MUSIC RECITALS

We host a recital at the end of each Fall and Spring term (December and May). The recital is a culmination of months of hard work from students and teachers alike. While it can be a little intimidating at first, many students find great joy performing for friends and family. Participation is encouraged but not required.

GROUP CLASSES

All group classes are 6-weeks long, and focus on a team-based approach to performance technique. We recommend students have at least one-year experience with their instrument of choice. Most classes perform a show at our monthly open mic after completion of the course. Start dates vary — visit our website, or contact us for more information. Every 6-week session costs **\$180 — no cancellations.**

ROCK SHOP

Rock Shop is the quickest and most effective way to learn to sing or play an instrument. Students collaborate, learn songs, and practice performance with the guidance of an Eastside teacher. Class themes vary — previous iterations include Motown, 80s Hits, and British Invasion.

JAZZ COMBO

A comprehensive approach to learning the art of Jazz Improvisation. Rooted in performance, students will focus on ear training, learning tunes, developing a blues vocabulary, rhythmic concepts, outlining chord changes, transcribing solos from jazz masters, in-depth analysis and discussion of various jazz styles.

GYPSY JAZZ ENSEMBLE

Guitarists, violinists, upright bassists, vocalists, and horns of all types are welcome! Taught by Jamey Cummins, students will discuss technique, theory and improvisation, concluding with a live performance.

CANCELLATIONS & CREDITS

All cancellations must be **submitted in email by 8:00 PM the night before your lesson**, with the option to **reschedule** or receive a **credit** toward next month's tuition. Credits are deducted from next invoice.

NO SHOW — **Late cancellations and any missed lesson without notice is forfeited** and balance due in full. Two consecutive missed lessons without notice may result in termination of lessons.

TUITION & BILLING

Weekly lessons are grouped together in a monthly invoice **emailed** to students and is due at the beginning of each month. All invoices are payable online (email link), or at the school; we accept card, cash, and check.

AUTO PAY — For your convenience, we offer automatic billing, drafted on the first day of each month. Just speak with a Studio Manager in-person to setup a card on file. Especially encouraged for bi-weekly students.

POLICIES

Lesson Times & Tardiness

Please arrive a few minutes early in order to assure lessons start on a timely basis. Lessons are often scheduled back-to-back; we cannot extend the length of a lesson with a late start time. PLEASE CALL if expecting to be late. Teachers are only required to wait up to 15 minutes after lesson start. Any lesson tardiness without notification beyond requirement is considered forfeited.

Substitute Teachers

Occasionally our teachers may need to miss a lesson due to schedule conflicts or unforeseen illness. Our policy for teacher absences is to match another qualified instructor for your scheduled lesson with notes about any current practice material. **“NO SUBS” — Please inform a Studio Manager if you prefer not to have a substitute when your teacher is away, and we will credit the lesson(s).**

Supplies & Store

We recommend a three-ring binder (or folder) for all assigned instructional material. Teachers may recommend guide books or practice journals to enhance student progress. Most required materials are available for purchase at the school store and can be added to next month’s invoice.

Withdrawal & Returning Students

Weekly students have priority on the calendar to secure their lesson time every week. We ask for two weeks notice if a student must suspend lessons before the end of a term. If you would like to return after hiatus, please contact the school to discuss scheduling options.

Lost and Found


Please keep track of personal items — We recommend writing full name on all instructional materials. Eastside Music School cannot be held liable for damage to vehicles or stolen property during lessons.

PARKING & FACILITIES ACCESS

Free parking is available in the Corazon parking garage located on San Marcos Street between E 5th & 6th St.

Gates are operated by a self-service ticket machine at entrance/exit, and spots are designated **501 Studios Guest Parking**. Tickets are time stamped and will be validated by our Studio Manager when students check out after lesson. Eastside Music will validate for length of lesson, plus 30 minutes.

Our entrance is on the **west side** of 501 Studios. **The building is locked weekdays after 5pm and on weekends**, per policy of 501 Studios — the Studio Manager will greet you at the door. You may also buzz the door bell if nobody is present.
